Policies and procedures are up to date and all staff are aware of their responsibilities within these. Staff are highly trained in Child Protection, eSafety, Health & Safety, Fire Procedures, First Aid and supervision at all times meets statutory requirements.

Our practice is regularly reviewed and everyone has a responsibility to listen to our children and report any concerns relating to children or staff behaviour through the appropriate channels.

We have consistent and positive behaviour management policies and regularly raise awareness about anti-bullying with all stakeholders. We believe that these arrangements ensure all children are safe and secure whilst at our school.
